EMERGENCY PROCEDURES (adopted from Emergency Procedures issued by The Venue)

EMERGENCY EVACUATION

Familiarise yourself with the area you are visiting, ensuring you are aware of the location of the nearest **FIRE EXITS** leading out from your area.

Upon hearing the **FIRE ALARM SIREN** the building must be evacuated immediately and all club members, officials and competitors should proceed via the nearest fire exit to the assembly point at the **front of the building**.

Swimming Pool users will be issued with Space Blankets and 'Held' by a lifeguard at the appropriate **'Fire Exit'**.

Please don't re-enter the building to reclaim any belongings until you are issued instructions from the Duty Manager that it is safe to re-enter.

FIRST AID TREATMENT

If you require first aid treatment please contact a member of staff and a qualified first aider will be immediately called for attendance.

HERTSMERE FLYERS SWIMMING CLUB COACHING STAFF will abide by the instructions issued by the staff of The Venue. They will, in addition, check that all swimmers signed in on the register have been accounted for and will take charge of all Club swimmers until the emergency and/or session is over.

Emergency contact details for parents/guardians of all Club swimmers will be held poolside by the coaching staff with the registers.
